Are We Complacent with Our Comfort?

As we ride our "wings" we all know that they were designed for comfort on the open road.

I recently experienced a "comfort" situation that sort of made me think a lot about my level of comfort and complacency with it. What was it that made me think? A simple thing I lost the use of my CB!!! Now I know that you are going to say, "big deal, ride without it". As we ride in groups, we always have a "drag", what is his duty? It's to let the leader know that all made it through the light, around the corner, around the last car etc.

Let's remember that the lead can't drive with his eyes glued to the mirror, he must rely on others to keep him abreast of everything. I'm used to riding in the rear, especially here in Florida I always kept our leader informed on the situation. I'm now having to rely on riding without communications. I need to use and read the Hand Signals to inform me of what is going on. I was complacent, the CB worked so all I ever had to do was listen or talk now I must watch closely for a signal from a frontal rider. I also had to relearn how to communicate without words. Let's not get too comfortable with our riding try shutting off your CB and practice the hand signals next time you are riding in a group.
